GCSE Maths and History Trip - Thursday 3 April

We have arranged for our Year 10 students to have the opportunity to travel to Bletchley Park to learn how the intelligence work at Bletchley Park during the World War II enabled the Allies to decipher the military codes and ciphers that secured German, Japanese, and other Axis nation's communications focusing on D Day.

The visit is on Thursday 3 April. We will travel by hired coach to Bletchley Park leaving school at approximately 07:00. Please arrive on North Street for no later than 06:45. We shall be setting off back from Bletchley Park at approximately 15:00 and therefore expect to return to school at approximately 19:00, dependent on traffic.

Students should bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water- and any routine medication which they usually carry, for example inhalers. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals a packed lunch can be provided, please email finance@heckgrammar.co.uk for further details.
